We have severe concerns regarding access into the site. As residents of Abbotsview Drive, we already experience difficulties exiting on to A7 at peak times in morning and evening. Additional housing would exacerbate this issue.

We question whether the infrastructure in the surrounding area can support additional housing - eg schools, drainage systems, local shops,

The tree line verging Boleside Road is extremely mature and thinning, this means that any housing is and will be clearly visible from Abbotsford House all year round.

Boleside is currently an important fishing area, bringing many tourists to our area. Building houses on the proposed site would have a detrimental impact on fishing through noise pollution.
