What are your comments regarding this Site?:

I am relieved to find (p.411, no paragraph number) recognition of the 'significant recent development at Dingleton Hospital' [EM32B] and a decision not to promote any further development sites within Melrose. Land off Dingleton Road has borne the brunt of recent development, including the proposed Croft housing site [EM4B], whose fit within the landscape I would dispute. My principal concern now however is the continuing impact of traffic on Dingleton Road. In the 12 years we have lived on the perimeter of the Dingleton Hospital site, vehicular traffic - construction, agricultural, public and private - has increased very considerably and this will be only exacerbated by The Croft development. I note your statement (p.412, no paragraph number) that 'there are capacity issues... particularly on Dingleton Road and Chiefswood Road'. There is however a degree of vagueness about your following suggestion (p.412, Development and Safeguarding Proposals, Housing, EM32B) of the 'possibility of a link from Dingleton Road to the wider development in the Dingleton area via Chiefswood Road' which concerns me. I think those of us who live in or close to the area deserve greater clarity.
