The Scottish Borders Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 1(1) and 152(2) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The Scottish Borders Council (B710, Caddonfoot) (Redetermination of Means of Exercise of Public Right of Passage) Order 2021 and shall come into operation on _____ 2022.
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. The road at B710, Caddonfoot, as specified in the Schedule to this Order currently a carriageway shall become a footway the right of passage exercisable by foot and cycle.

ROAD OVER WHICH MEANS OF EXERCISE OF PUBLIC RIGHT OF PASSAGE IS TO BE REDETERMINED

Section of B710 26 metres from its junction with the A707, north for a distance of 3 metres
