Ward 7 - East Berwickshire

I will now declare the result of the election in the Ward 7 - East Berwickshire. There are 3 Councillors to be elected.
The electorate was 9,029 and the number of ballot papers received was 4,287 giving a percentage turnout of $47.5 \%$. There were 49 rejected ballot papers. The quota of votes for a candidate to be elected was 1,060 .
