I will now declare the result of the election in the Ward 8 - Kelso \& District. There are 3 Councillors to be elected.
The electorate was 8,499 and the number of ballot papers received was 3,990 giving a percentage turnout of $46.9 \%$. There were 70 rejected ballot papers. The quota of votes for a candidate to be elected was 981.
