

DANGEROUS WILD ANIMALS CONDITIONS

- 1. (i) The animal(s) shall be kept by no person other than the person or persons specified in this licence;
 - (ii) The animal(s) shall normally be held at the premises specified in this licence;
 - (iii) The animal(s) shall not be moved from those premises or shall only be moved from them in the circumstances specified in this licence;
 - (iv) A current insurance policy shall be held by the licensee to cover liability for any damage which may be caused by the animal(s); and
 - (v) the terms of the policy shall be satisfactory to Scottish Borders Council.
- 2. The licensee shall at all reasonable times make available a copy of this licence to any person entitled to keep any animal under the authority of the licence.
- 3. Animal(s) must be kept in escape proof accommodation of an adequate size. The temperature, lighting and ventilation must be kept at a suitable level. The accommodation must be well-drained and clean.
- 4. An adequate supply of suitable food, drink and bedding must be provided.
- 5. The animal(s) must be visited at regular intervals.
- 6. Appropriate steps must be taken to protect the animal(s) from fire or other emergency.
- 7. Reasonable precautions must be taken to prevent and control the spread of infectious disease.
- 8. The maximum number and types of animals permitted to be kept on the premises to which the licence relates are as set out below, and must not be exceeded:-
