* Section 58 to the Building (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 2004, as amended: Copying of drawings and detailed information in Part 2 of the register is, however, subject to certain restrictions. For residential buildings (including individua dwellings), copying is limited to anyone with an interest in the building, such as the current (or prospective) owner, occupier of tenant, known as an 'interested party'. Copying is also extended to an 'interested party' of an adjoining building.
