## **PARTICIPATION REQUEST UNDER THE COMMUNITY EMPOWERMENT (SCOTLAND) ACT 2015**

### **DECISION NOTICE - AGREED**

This Decision Notice relates to the participation request made by Ednam Parents on 22 April 2025 in relation to the provision of qualitative and quantitative data specific to Ednam, and the need for a thorough assessment of the value and impact on children, families, the school, and the wider community.

We propose that the outcome improvement process will operate as follows:

- Whilst the working group on SBC's early learning and childcare (including the mothballing policy) will not be specific to Ednam, SBC will ensure that a representative of the Ednam community is considered for co-option into the group or invited to contribute to its work where relevant, particularly where local insight can inform broader policy development.

As the community participation body that made the participation request, we expect your group to participate in the proposed process as follows:

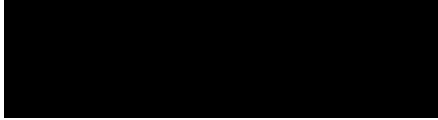
- Work in partnership with Ednam Primary School Parent Council and any other relevant organisation or individual with an interest in early years provision in Ednam.
- Submit qualitative and quantitative data specific to Ednam to inform SBC's early learning and childcare policies.

Your group is entitled to make written submissions in relation to modifying the proposed outcome improvement process. Any such submissions must be made within 28 days of the date of this decision notice. If you suggest any modifications to the process, we will contact you within 56 days of the date of this decision notice with details of the outcome improvement process that will be established.
