1. That area of land owned by Forestry and Land Scotland as outlined and cross-hatched in red on the map marked "Glentress Forest, Peebles, Scottish Borders" annexed hereto.

The purpose for which the Order is made is to accommodate the safe operation of the Tweedlove MTB endurance event.

The Order will be in effect from 08:00 until 17:00 on Saturday 27 September 2025, unless revoked earlier.
