NOTICE TO EXEMPT LAND FROM ACCESS RIGHTS

INNERLEITHEN TWEED VALLEY FOREST PARK AREA

18 AND 19 APRIL 2026

Notice is hereby given under Section 11(9) of the Land Reform (Scotland) Act 2003 (“the Act”) that on 3 April 2026 the Scottish Borders Council made the Scottish Borders Council (Innerleithen Tweed Valley Forest Park Area) (Exemption from Access Rights) Order 2026 (“the Order”) under Section 11(1) of the Act.

The effect of the Order is to exempt the following land from the access rights which would otherwise be exercisable in respect of that land by virtue of Part 1 of the Act:

1. Those areas of land owned by Forestry and Land Scotland as outlined and cross-hatched in red on the map marked “Scottish Borders Innerleithen Tweed Valley Forest Park Area” annexed hereto.

The purpose for which the Order is made is to accommodate the safe operation of the Scottish Enduro Series, Innerleithen Round, Mountain Bike Event.

The Order will be in effect as follows:

from 08:00 to 18:00 on Saturday 18 April 2026,
from 08:00 to 18:00 on Sunday 19 April 2026,

unless revoked earlier.

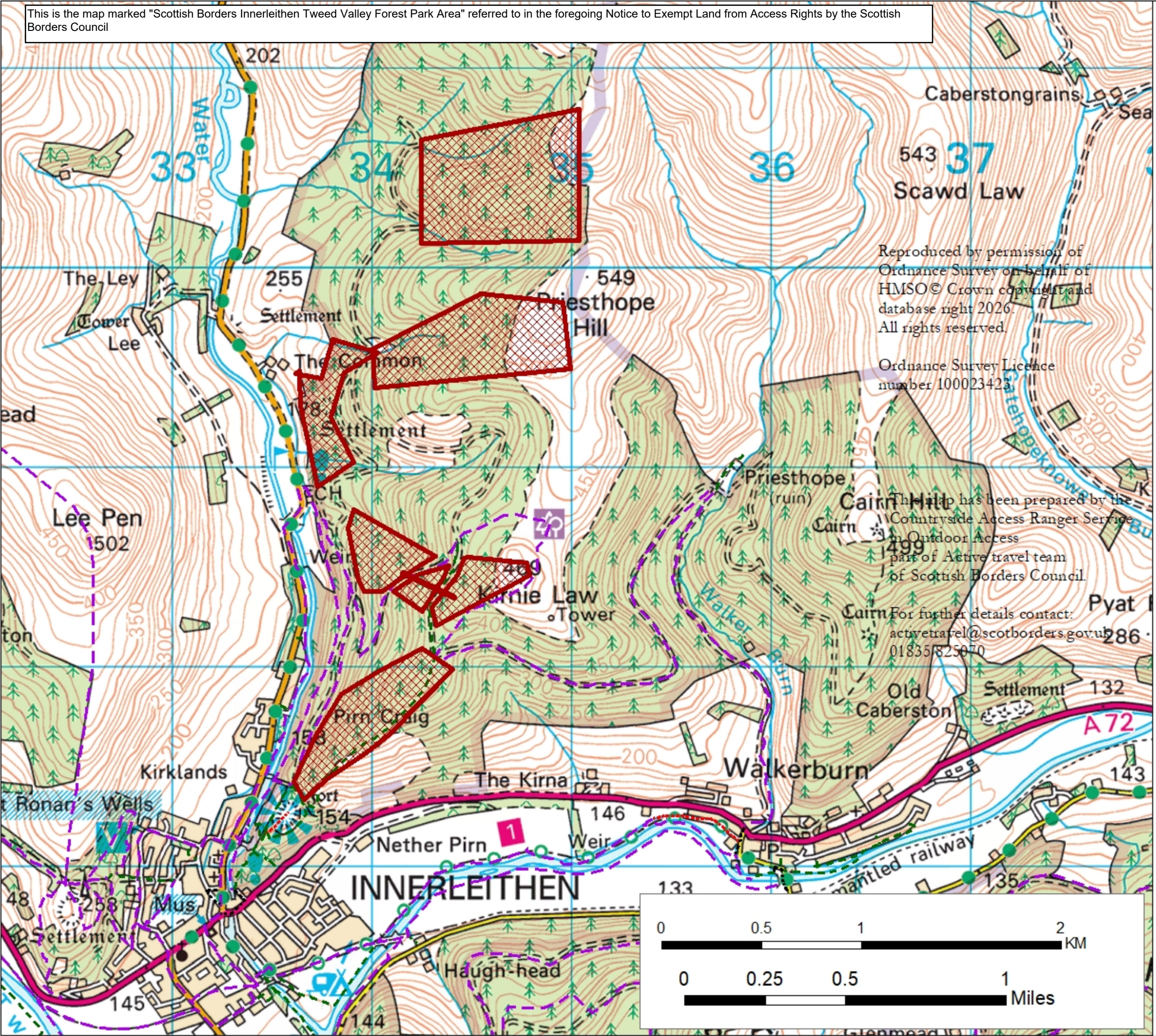
