

THE SCOTTISH BORDERS COUNCIL
(JIM CLARK RALLY)
(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2026

The Scottish Borders Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The Scottish Borders Council (Jim Clark Rally) (Temporary Traffic Regulation) Order 2026. The Order, which has a maximum duration of three days, shall come into force at 07:30 on 22 May 2026 and is expected to remain in effect until 20:00 on 24 May 2026. The Order is required to allow the staging of the 2026 Jim Clark Rally on certain closed public roads.
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 below, while this Order is in effect no person shall, without the authority of the Council:
 - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle; or
 - (b) permit any vehicle to wait or to be parked; or
 - (c) ride, or cause or permit to be ridden any cycle, or ride, lead or drive any animal; or
 - (d) walk,along those lengths of road on the dates and at the times specified in the Schedule to this Order.
4. A temporary 20mph speed restriction will be in force from 08:00 on 22 May 2026 to 20:00 on 24 May 2026 on Station Road, Duns from the existing 20mph signs southwards to a point 50 metres south of its junction with the C101 Gavinton Road.
5. Notwithstanding the above in the case of an emergency any officer of the Council, the police, the ambulance service, fire brigade or the statutory undertakers may require the promoter to stop the rally and may enter upon such public road or part of a public road with any necessary vehicles, plant and equipment for the purpose of exercising any of their functions in relation to the emergency.
6. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times during the closures. Pedestrian access to residential properties on or adjacent to the roads will be permitted at safe intervals and will be escorted by marshals on site.

The Scottish Borders Council (Jim Clark Rally) (Temporary Traffic Regulation) Order 2026 is being made under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended. The Order, which has a maximum duration of three days, will come into force at 07:30 on 22 May 2026 and is expected to remain in effect until 20:00 on 24 May 2026. The Order is required to allow the staging of the 2026 Jim Clark Rally on certain closed public roads.

When the Order comes into effect no person shall, without the authority of the Council:

- (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle; or
- (b) permit any vehicle to wait or to be parked; or
- (c) ride, or cause or permit to be ridden any cycle, or ride, lead or drive any animal; or
- (d) walk,

along those lengths of road on the dates and at the times specified in the Schedule below.

Pedestrian access to residential properties on or adjacent to the roads will be permitted at safe intervals and will be escorted by marshals on site.

A temporary 20mph speed restriction will be in force from 08:00 on 23 May 2026 to 20:00 on 25 May 2026 on Station Road, Duns from the existing 20mph signs southwards to a point 50 metres south of its junction with the C101 Gavinton Road.
