# RIDONKULOUS BRIDGES TRAIL

The RIDONKULOUS Hawick Bridges Trail has been designed as a one-way route, stretching roughly 5 miles (8km).

From Jooglie Brig (1) to Langlands Bridge (3), the trail follows a quiet countryside road, so walkers should stay alert for passing traffic.

Between Langlands Bridge (3) and Weensland Bridge (13), the route becomes an easy, mostly level walk along well-surfaced paths, following the Active Travel Network.

After Weensland Bridge (13), the route follows the Borders Abbey Way, and becomes slightly more challenging, with paths that are less defined.

**Start / Finish:** Jooglie Brig / Hornshole Bridge

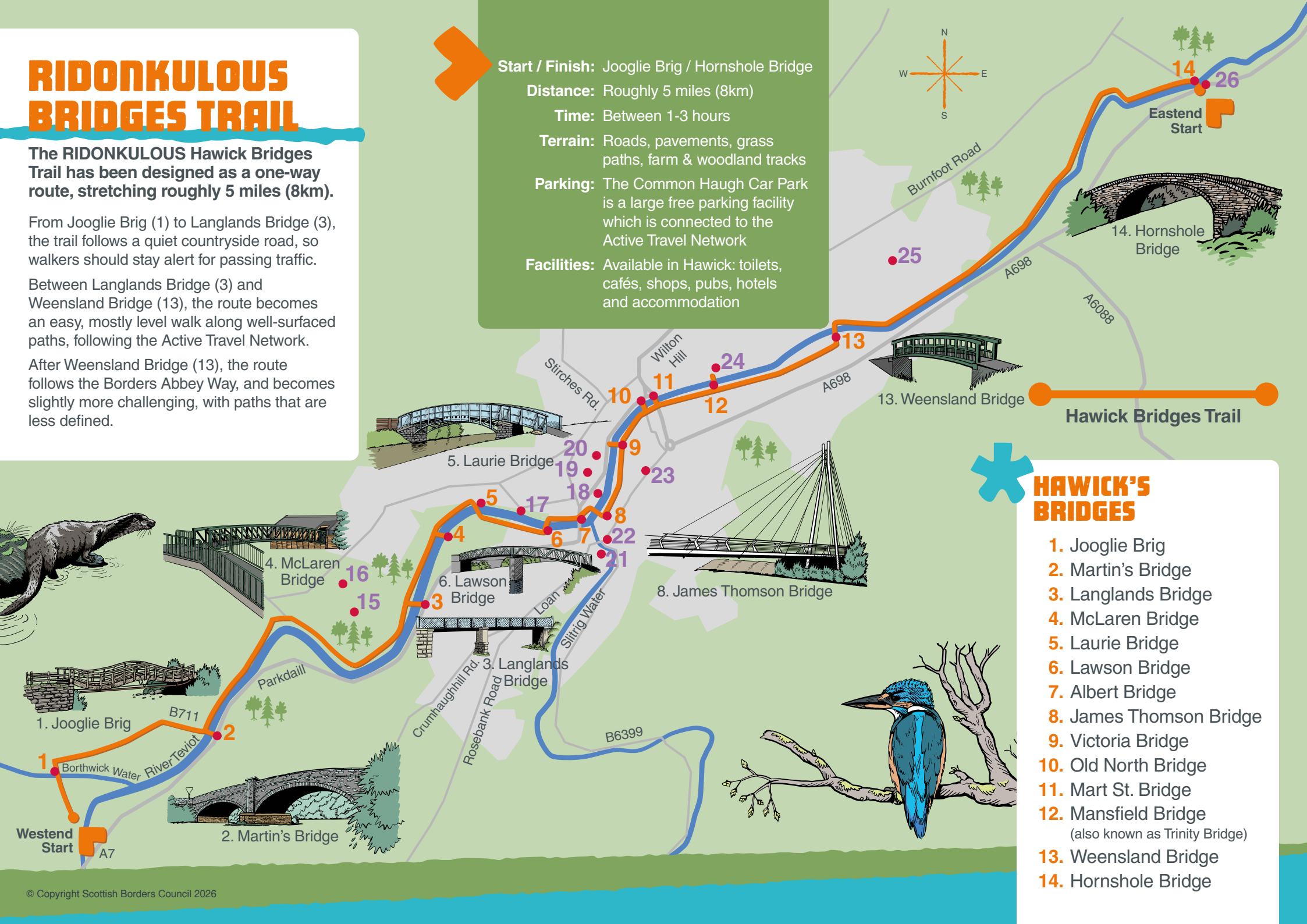
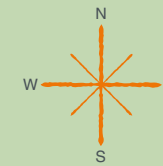
**Distance:** Roughly 5 miles (8km)

**Time:** Between 1-3 hours

**Terrain:** Roads, pavements, grass paths, farm & woodland tracks

**Parking:** The Common Haugh Car Park is a large free parking facility which is connected to the Active Travel Network

**Facilities:** Available in Hawick: toilets, cafés, shops, pubs, hotels and accommodation
