If the tenant refuses to sign the agreement or any part of the agreement it will in no way affect the tenancy or the tenants rights.

Please note that the tenant will be responsible for any costs of reinstatement or repair arising from lost keys or changed locks, and will be required to return or reinstate all keys or original locks at the end of the tenancy.
