

Zinio eMagazines – Kindle Fire HD

To use our new eMagazine service you must create an account.

On the tablet open web page <http://www.rbdigital.com/scottishborders/zinio>

Tap Create New Account




Enter your library card number and tap **Next**

You can now choose which magazines you wish to subscribe to by clicking on them in the list.

Tap on an item to view full item information.



Tick the box to sign up to be emailed when the next issue is available if required then tap **Checkout**



Tap **Keep Browsing** to subscribe to more eMagazines or tap **Start Reading** to view this one.


Some magazines are part of the SBLibraries current subscription, with the latest editions shown at the top and back issues listed below.

Some titles have been removed from the subscription and only back issues are available.


First time use only - There is a **Zinio for Libraries** app available for the device you are using

Tap the **Kindle HD/HDX** link under the **Start Reading** button

You will be prompted to download the file, click **OK**




The file will download in the background, pull down the status bar on the top of the screen to view the progress



Once the download has completed you can install it from Downloads


Tap the Home button then tap Web.

In the browser tap the Menu button  to open the sidebar then select Downloads




Tap the ZinioForLibraries_latest.apk entry to start the install

Security settings may block this installation, click Settings to allow it




Change the setting for Apps from Unknown Sources to ON – you can change this back as soon as the install is finished.




You will be presented with a security warning, in this instant we know that the app is safe so click OK


Tap the back arrow then tap the ZinioForLibraries_latest.apk entry again to start the installation



Click Install to confirm



Tap Open when this process is completed and login.



Reading an eMagazine

When you have checked out all of your chosen magazines from the website you can read them through the Zinio app.

Open the app and tap the **Download** icon  to download the titles you want to read.


You must have a Wi-Fi connection to download the items but once downloaded you can open and read them anywhere.

Delete an eMagazine

In the Zinio app, tap on the Edit icon



Select **Remove** then tap the X on the magazine that you want to delete.



Restore an eMagazine

In the Zinio app, tap on the Edit icon



Select **Restore** then tap the + on the magazine that you want to restore.
