3. If the reason the skip is required is associated with the demolition of a building or other structure a copy of a detailed method statement for the demolition of the building or other structure must be enclosed with this application.

I understand I will be required to ensure that each skip or group of skips while on the road are marked, guarded and lit in accordance with the following requirements:

- a. Each skip shall not exceed 5 metres in length by 2 metres in width and shall be clearly and indelibly marked with its owner's name and with his telephone number or address. The ends of each skip shall be painted yellow.
- b. In full compliance with The Builders Skips (Markings) (Scotland) Regulations 1986 there shall be fitted to the skip(s), as near to the top outer corners of the ends as the construction of the skip allows, red and yellow fluorescent/reflective markings on vertical plates as described in the regulations.
- c. Each skip shall be guarded by at least 3 traffic cones placed on the carriageway in an oblique line on the approach side of the skip.
- d. At night a lamp shall be placed against or attached to each corner of the skip. Lamps shall comply with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions.

I hereby apply to place a builder's skip on the road and agree to satisfy the requirements imposed on me by Scottish Borders Council if permission is granted. I note that an application fee of £36 will be charged which is valid for a period of 3 months from the date the skip permit is granted. A fee of £36 will be due for each subsequent 3 month period.
