ROADS (SCOTLAND) ACT 1984 SECTION 58 (2) APPLICATION TO ERECT SCAFFOLDING ON A ROAD

Permission to erect a scaffold on a road will only be granted on the understanding that the scaffold is to be erected and maintained safe at all times by the applicant and /or user.
