## APPLICATION TO OCCUPY PART OF A ROAD FOR DEPOSIT OF BUILDING MATERIALS ETC

A person who without, or otherwise than in accordance with, the written permission of The Roads Authority, in conducting operations for the construction, repair, maintenance or demolition of any building, occupies, for the purpose or depositing materials or otherwise in connection with those operations, a part of a road, whether or private, commits an offence.
