Scottish Borders Council Family and Dog Fun Day opens on Friday 7 July at 11am at Wilton Lodge Park, Hawick (next to the Zandra Elliot Bandstand).

The Dog Show starts at 12noon. Please arrive early to collect a copy of the dog show timetable from the information point (located next to the show ring).

A maximum of 10 dogs may be entered into each category.

Only dogs over the age of 12 weeks will be allowed to take part in the dog show.

Valid vaccination certificates must be shown to organisers on the day of competition for dogs entered in to the puppy category (no proof of vaccination means no entry).

The judge's decision is final. Rosettes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in each category at the end of the dog show (approximately 3pm).

As there are limited spaces available, pre-registration is recommended to confirm your place.

Please remember this is a fun dog show and while we welcome competitive applicants, we are looking forward to meeting dogs of all shapes, sizes and abilities.

Health and Safety rules

Dog owners are responsible for their dogs.

Dogs must remain on lead and be under the owner's control and supervision at all times.

Dog owners must clear up any mess created by their dog.



Your dog is at risk if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm.

Water will be available for your dog on site.

If you fail to comply with the organiser's rules you may be asked to leave and you will not be refunded for entry to the dog show.

Please consider if your dog will be happy in an environment surrounded by crowds of people and unfamiliar dogs. If your dog is reactive/aggressive, it would be in your dog's best interests to remain at home while you attend the event.

Staff/volunteers will be on site wearing ID and happy to help.
