BORDERS SEARCH & RESCUE UNIT

This bid is to part fund the building of a new mountain rescue base to house all the vehicles and equipment for the volunteers to use for training and call outs. The base will also be used for open days, education, providing first aid/CPR training for the community.

G10 SPORTS
