TEVIOT & LIDDESDALE PROJECTS FUNDING AVAILABLE: £38,000

ARTBEAT STUDIOS

The bid is to part fund the provision of local art/craft/creative/music activities for the whole community. To run after school, during the evening (especially winter) and at weekends. It will provide a creative 'community hub' for all the community to share the experience.

BONCHESTER DEVELOPMENT TRUST

The bid is to help form a Community Trust with the aim of creating a hostel, an arts centre and a community shop in Hobkirk. Initially the Trust will run small projects to generate public interest and match funds from other sources.

BORDERS GREEN TEAM

The bid is to help people with various disabilities, aged 20-54 years, develop their skills for life in woodworking, painting and marketing products. Flat pack bird houses and tables will be developed to be sold in the community and wooden puzzles sold through a local outlet.

BURNFOOT COMMUNITY FUTURES

BCF wish to deliver a new events training plan and an extended Community events calendar which will run throughout the course of 2018. The events are tailored for Children and Families aiming to enhance social, cultural and educational opportunities.

DAD'S ROCK

This bid is for a dads/male carers group to work together with their children to build an outdoor learning/playzone within Burnfoot Primary School. The group will build tables/planters and create paths/trim trail benefitting the pupils, and local community outwith school time.

BID **£5,000**

ESCAPE YOUTH SERVICES

The bid is to fund the installation of two 10 meter traverse climbing walls in the Youth Café games hall; open 5 nights a week. It would improve health, fitness and social skills associated with team sports & group engagement and add to the range of sports offered.

BID **£8,000**

G10 SPORTS

The bid is to fund taking the new and exciting sport of Floorball into as many schools as possible. It has the aim of improving physical and mental health. It is fun, helps maintain healthy weight and improves co-ordination and social skills. Floorball is growing in The Borders.

BID **€5,000**

HAWICK COMMUNITY PUMP TRACK

The bid is to part fund the building of a community Pump Track at Wilton Lodge Park. A Pump Track is a continuous loop of banked turns and rollers, used by bikes/BMXs, skateboards and inline skates - the rider 'pumps' their body to move. It will cater for all ages and abilities.

HAWICK CONGREGATIONAL COMMUNITY CHURCH

The bid is to part fund the start of an intergenerational Friendship Club, for all aged 0 to 90+, to reduce loneliness and isolation. Activities will include art/craft/tea dance/music/cooking ideas/thrifty tips to be shared and learned by all who attend.

BID **£800**

HAWICK MEN'S SHED

The bid is to adapt a small vacant room in new premises into a kitchen facility for the benefit of the members. This will be used for cooking, cooking instruction and hobbies to improve meal making skills. The volunteers have been identified to deliver the cooking sessions. BID **£8,882**

NEWCASTLETON POLYSPORT/COPSHAW CUTTERS

The bid is to part fund the establishment of a group, purchase a ride on rotary grass cutter and manage the maintenance and use by the whole community. This will improve access to areas which aren't currently maintained, improve disabled/public access and enhance the village.

BID **£5,000**

TOWN OF 1000 TRAILS

The bid is to part fund the development of a website, signage, marked routes and route information for walkers, runners, cyclists, mountain bikers, horse riders, canoeists etc in the TD9 area. This will lead to greater use of the land and bring people together and encourage tourism.

E3,000

WILLIAM LAIDLAW MEMORIAL HALL

The bid is to start a regular, two weekly session of games and socialising aimed at the older and retired members of the Bonchester and Hobkirk communities. Including table top games, indoor curling/bowls, it will be a tea/coffee afternoon with the activities and open to all.

BID **£1,300**

WORKING FOR WILTON COMMUNITY GROUP

The bid is to work with others to improve/maintain an unsightly area in Dickson Street. Wood/plants/soil/ paint/bin screens and LED lighting need to be purchased. The Men's Shed will make flower boxes maintained by local pupils and voluntary community litter picks will start.
