

WILTON LODGE PARK TRAVEL DIRECTIONS

The park benefits from a large car parking facility (The Common Haugh Car Park) as well as being connected to a comprehensive road and path network; which provides multiple options for pedestrians, cyclists and public transport users as well as those looking to arrive by car.

Arriving by car from A7/A698 North

- The Common Haugh Car Park (410 spaces) serves the town centre as well as the park and other local facilities;
- A linear car park (approx. 50 spaces) is located alongside Wilton Park Road; running between the walled garden and changing pavilion;
- Further parking for disabled drivers and museum staff (10 spaces) is provided in a small car park at the bottom of Top Drive, off Wilton Park Road, close to the museum;
- Another small car park is located above the museum opposite the allotments on Wilton Park Road;
- 2 new disabled parking bays have been created adjacent to the museum as part of the HLF funded project.

Arriving by car from A7 South

- The Volunteer Car Park has created 14 new parking spaces as part of the 3G pitch development, to supplement the existing 29 spaces. Three disabled bays were also delivered as part of this development. The new Car park also provides provision for coach drop off for the heritage and sporting attractions in the area.

Public Transport

For those arriving by bus there is a stop near to the Common Haugh Car Park on the A7 as well as another bus stop opposite the Volunteer Park.

Arriving by Foot from the Common Haugh Car Park

A short riverside path takes the public past “The Cauld”, a salmon ladder on the river. The path leads up to the main gates at the lodge of the former estate. This is also the main route to the park from the Town Centre via the Albert Bridge.

Arriving by Foot from the Volunteer Car Park

Public can gain access to the park via the newly installed McLaren Bridge which provides a direct link from the Volunteer Park to the new café and playpark. Public can also access the park from the Langland’s Bridge from Buccleuch Road A7 South.

Arriving by Foot from the Walled Garden


Public can gain access to the park via a footpath which is located directly opposite the parking area at the Walled Garden which then links to the central path within the park.

Arriving by Foot from the Wilton Park Road (Opposite Allotments)

Public can gain access to the park via a timber stepped footpath which is located to the right hand side of the parking area and links to the central path near to the Museum.
