If the tenant is 8 weeks or more in arrears with their rent, the law allows for payment of Local Housing Allowance to be made directly to the landlord unless it is in the overriding interests of the claimant or his family not to do so.

If you are aware your tenant is claiming or is in receipt of Housing Benefit and they are 8 weeks or more in arrears and you would like us to consider paying Housing Benefit direct to you, please fill in this form and return it to us, together with the proof we ask for. We will send you our decision within 14 days. Please note that if you cannot send the proof we ask for, it may delay our decision. This may mean that payments will continue to be made to your tenant.

Please note, if your tenant has arrears as they are legally withholding rent due to a dispute with you, we cannot pay Housing Benefit directly to you.
