

NOTES

All Dimensions are in millimetres unless otherwise stated.

FENCE

Softwood posts 100 x 100 x 2450mm long at 1800mm centres, tops weathered as shown.

Softwood rails sawn 100 x 50mm fixed to posts with 2No. 125mm Galvanised nails per end.

Softwood pales aswn 100 x 25mm fixed alternately on either side of rails with 2No. 65mm galvanised per rail.

All timber to be CCA pressure treated.

HEDGE

Provide 1.8 - 2.0m wide weed and grass free strip for hedge. Cultivate trench 1.5m wide \times 0.45m deep. Add compost and fertiliser as required.

Plant in double staggered row at 0.5m centres and 1.0m apart. (One row either side of fence).

Use cell grown, container grown or barerooted plants.

To protect bare rooted plants from drying out, keep roots covered until immediately before planting and use root dip.

Where necessary to protect against browsing provide stock and rabbit proof fence on either side of hedge or protect with stout canes and spiral guards.

Maintain weed and grass free for a minimum period of 2 years post-planting to ensure establishment.

Trim hedge to A - shaped profile, outwith bird nesting season.

Some suitable species and mixes:

Evergreen Ilex aquifolium (Holly) Ligustrum ovalifolium (Privet) Mixes: Add 30% - 50% Hedera helix (Ivy) Lonicera periclymenum (Honeysuckle) Rosa canina (Dog Rose) Rosa rubiginosa (Sweet Briar) Rosa rubrifolia

Deciduous (for most rural situations) Fagus sylvatica (Beech) Carpinus betulus (Hornbeam) Crataegus monogyna (Hawthorn) Prunus spinosa (Blackthorn or sloe) Berberis aggregata (Barberry)
