DECISION NOTICE - AGREED

This Decision Notice relates to the participation request made by Eyemouth & District Community Trust on 10 May 2018 in relation to community participation in the economic Regeneration of Eyemouth. Scottish Borders Council has decided to agree to the request.

We currently have an outcome improvement process in place which you are invited to participate in. This process will entail Eyemouth Community Development Trust participating in the Eyemouth & East Berwickshire Economic Regeneration Group (EEBERG). EEBERG is a sub group of the Council's Executive Committee, established on 17 April to consider the issues and opportunities facing businesses and the economy in the Eyemouth & East Berwickshire area. The role of the Working Group is to offer advice and guidance to the Executive Committee based on information collected and analysed over the coming months. We expect Eyemouth & District Community Trust to bring its knowledge and experience of local community needs and wishes to the process.

The outcome improvement process will start within 90 days of the date of this decision notice.
