Why we collect and use your information:

We have a legal duty under the Education (school lunches) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2013 as defined under Part 1 of the Welfare Reform Act 2012 to provide a free meal to all children in the first three years of Primary school and other children whose parents are in receipt of the qualifying benefits. In order to ensure that we continue to provide this service to qualifying families, we have organised for packed lunches to be available for collection from local hubs or if you are unable to collect from these locations, deliver meals to your home or issue you with an e-voucher to use in a supermarket.

This notice is to inform you that if you have opted to have meals delivered to your home, we will need to share your name and address with our contracted school transport operators as part of our public task. You can find out more about which operators are contracted by us on our <u>website</u>.
