How we will use your information

The contact details, presentations and videos you have provided will be kept securely and confidentially. They will be retained until the conclusion of the Design Awards 2022. The high resolution photographs will be kept by the council for the purposes of promoting good design until you request their deletion.

If you have consented to being contacted regarding Doors Open Days, your contact details will also be used to administer and contact you for participation in forthcoming Doors Open Days (held every September). They will be held securely and confidentially for this purpose until you request their deletion / confirm you no longer wish to participate in Doors Open Days.

The Council is relying on your consent to collect and use this information. You can withdraw consent at any time by emailing heritage@scotborders.gov.uk where your information will be securely deleted.

Who we may share your information with

Your information will be accessed by Council staff who need to use it in order to provide the services described above. Your contact details will not be shared with third parties.

The application forms (redacted), presentations, videos and high resolution photographs will be shared with the judging panel using <u>WeTransfer</u>, and may be shown at the Awards Ceremony. The judging panel consists of a representative from Borders Distillery (as lay chairperson), and nominated built environment experts including those from the RTPI and RIAS.

The high resolution photographs may additionally be shared publicly for the purpose of promoting good design in the Borders.

Your information may also be shared and analysed internally in order to provide management information, inform service delivery reform and similar purposes to meet our duty to achieve best value and continuous service improvement.

In general the Council does not transfer personal data outside either the UK or the European Economic Area (EEA) and on the rare occasions when it does so the Council will inform you. In this case, the transfer of documents via WeTransfer does involve the transfer of data outside the UK and EEA.
