To be eligible to apply you should be in a position to answer 'Yes' to the points in the following list:

Is your group non profit-making and one of the following:

- Voluntary or community group/organisation
- School
- Community Council
- Church

Does your group have a bank account in its own name which requires at least 2 unrelated people to authorise all cheques and withdrawals?

If your group doesn't have its own bank account have you identified a partner organisation who could receive the grant on your behalf?

The Queen's Platinum Jubilee Fund can offer funding of up to £2,500. The funding requested should be the minimum required to enable the project to go ahead.

Please ensure that you have quotes for the items you want to purchase.

Only one funding application can be made to the Fund by any single group. A constituted group can hold a grant for a non-constituted group and apply for a grant in their own right.

If your project involves construction or refurbishment of a building you need to have heritable ownership of the land or building, or hold a lease which cannot be brought to an end by the landlord for at least 5 years. You should also have contacted Scottish Borders Council Development Control Officers in advance to discuss projects where they involve physical works. Planning permission needs to be in place before applying for funding.

Please note: Bank statements must be in the same name as the name of the applicant group/organisation given on page one of this application.
